NEF Funds 9 Fall Grants — Including One For Needham High!

In its fall grant cycle, Needham Education Foundation (NEF) awarded 9 grants totaling \$30,501 that will benefit students throughout the Needham Public Schools. The grant that will directly impact students at Needham High includes:

- A workshop with Cuerd@s, an organization that provides embroidered clothing to support mental health, for students in the Connections program at Needham High School.
 Connections is a therapeutic program developed to meet the needs of students with emotional disabilities. The tactile nature of the embroidery serves as a built-in de-escalation technique to help remind the wearer that they are safe, loved, and valued. The workshop will provide students the chance to embroider clothing to donate to a local mental health organization and to embroider a sweatshirt for themselves.

Peter J. Eloranta Scholarship




