## A Reminder From the Health Office - January 2024

Dear Parents and Students,

The Needham High School Health Office is seeing an increase in COVID, flu cases and respiratory illnesses.

Please stay home if you experience symptoms.

Prioritize your health by testing for COVID (we recommend Covid testing at least 3-5 days in a row) when symptoms start, following the Covid protocols, and adhere to our Illness guidelines. When you have a high fever and continued respiratory symptoms beyond 3 days consult your physician.

Most medical offices can test for Covid, Flu, Strep, Mononucleosis, RSV and other illnesses. Call your medical provider with any concerns or worsening symptoms

As exams and the end of the semester (January 19) approaches, let's prioritize everyone's well-being.

Please call the Health Office with any concerns or questions.

Get a medical note if you require an excused absence.


